Adults are free however to take their sons out back packing one on one. However, if the scout does not qualify for the event then he will not be allowed to participate with the troop. They will not be considered a part of the scouting event, nor will they be included in the tour permit. This is necessary to protect our troop and the Boy Scouts if something should happen while the adult and son are operating outside of BSA policy.

Anyone showing up to an event unprepared will not be allowed to participate as the rules set in place by the Boy Scouts of America and our troop are design to protect everyone involved.
